SIR BREWNOR LE NOYER - LA COTE MALE TAYLE

On one of the trails the PC will come upon a fierce battle where one knight is fighting against five knights. If the PC looks carefully at the battle, he will find that one of the five knights has a woman he is holding hostage. The PC may choose to assist the one knight or may choose to pass by the event. If the PC assists the one knight, he and the one knight will overcome the five and the woman will be rescued. When the PC asks the knight his name he replies "La Cote Male Tayle." This is due to the very ragged garment he wears over his armor. When the PC asks him why he wears such a ragged coat, La Cote Male Tayle tells the PC that it belonged to his father who was viciously murdered. He tells the PC that Sir Kay gave him the name when he (Sir Brewnor) first arrived in Camelot. When the PC asks what the battle was about, La Cote Male Tayle tells the PC that he undertook a quest to assist the Lady Maledysaunte when, in their travels, they were set upon by the five knights. La Cote Male Tayle tells the PC that he undertook the quest as his first assignment since being made a knight and he hopes to successfully complete it, or die honorably while trying. If the PC offers to help, La Cote Male Tayle thanks him but tells him that he must accomplish the task by himself to gain the honor for the Round Table.

If the PC chooses to assist the five knights, after killing the one knight, the five will turn and attack the PC.
